President R. Barbara Gitenstein was appointed President of The College of New Jersey by the Board of Trustees effective January

2, 1999, and

Whereas:

The Board approved an employment agreement for the President effective July 1, 2001 recognizing that in order to fulfill its responsibility of supporting the President of The College and serving the best interests of the institution, it was necessary to

ensure that such an agreement was in place, and

Whereas:

The Board of Trustees underwent a review of the agreement with the President, clarifying language throughout the document, confirming that the terms remain acceptable to the Board and the

President, and

Whereas:

During a recent review of the President's performance the Board noted that her leadership in the area of development has led to an extraordinary increase in the institution's endowment which has further strengthened the College's ability to fundraise successfully

in order to further institutional initiatives, and

Whereas:

Consistent with the terms of the former and current contract the Board wishes to award a one-time bonus to the president in

recognition of this achievement.

Therefore,

Be It

Resolved:

That the Board of Trustees of The College of New Jersey hereby approves the updated employment agreement for President R.

Barbara Gitenstein, recommended by the Executive Committee, and awards a one-time payment of 8% of her base salary to the

president.

Be It Further

Resolved:

That this agreement will be retroactively effective July 1, 2007.
