inspirational communications skills with the internal and external community, including state and local government representatives, has been particularly noteworthy during this time and has established the

foundation for long term planning for the college; and

Whereas: During her first year, President Foster exhibited steady, thoughtful

leadership in successfully addressing challenging circumstances; and

Whereas: President Foster's focus on ensuring that the college maintains an

inclusive, diverse community led to many campus conversations and the creation of a Division on Equity and Inclusion and the search for

an inaugural vice president for Equity and Inclusion; and

Whereas: Under her leadership, the college exceeded its FY20 financial
